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6 DAYS NEPAL PANORAMA

Day 01 Kuala Lumpur - Kathmandu

Upon arrival at Kathmandu meet and greet by our local representative from **Clasic Tours sdn bhd**, transferred to the hotel. After a short rest by visiting the 2000 years old Swoyambhunath stupa, (UNESCO World heritage site in 1979) sometimes also known as the monkey temple. The temple charms with its great dazzling stupa, while at the same time offers a marvelous view of Kathmandu Valley. Next destination is Patan, (UNESCO World heritage site in 1979) the oldest and second largest of the three cities in Kathmandu valley. Patan likes to recall its old name LALITPUR (city of beauty). Above all, it remains a proud city of artisans; Patan produces nearly all Nepal's fine metal work. Enroute, stop at a Tibetan carpet factory where you can see the spinning, dyeing and weaving of Tibetan carpets. Drive Back to hotel.

Day 02 Kathmandu – Pokhara

After breakfast, we will drive you up to Pokhara, the second largest and the most city in Nepal. Upon arrival, check in to hotel. In the evening, boating at Fewa lake for 1 hour. At the time of boating you have a chance to see the beautiful Himalayan panorama, specially (Fishtail) Machhapuchhare, Annapurna, Dhaulagiri Himal. Walk back or drive back to hotel with lots of shopping in lake side area.

Day 03 Pokhara

A half day tour of Pokhara is in store for you and we will visit various parts of the lakeside village, and enjoy one of the most beautiful panoramas in the world made up by the Annapurna Himal, the majestic Machhapuchhare and other surrounding snow-capped peaks. Afternoon or morning we will be visiting Davis fall, followed by the Tibetan refugee camp where the barter trading is still being practiced. Then we will be visiting old market or Pokhara and Vindhebasini Temple as well as Seti George.

Day 04 Pokhara – Kathmandu-Nagarkot

After breakfast drive to airport to take a flight to Kathmandu (USD 102.00 + USD 3.00 domestic tax) Upon arrival in Kathmandu will proceed to go Nagarkot, which is at a height of 2300 m above the sea level. From this lovely scenic spot you can catch the excellent view of the Himalayan range at sunset and even Mount Everest on a clear day.

Day 05 Nagarkot – Kathmandu

Wake up early and have a good view of the breathtaking Nagarkot, which provides an excellent scenery of the mountain ranges Langtang, Amadablam, Dorje Lhakpa, Chobha bhamre, Manaslu etc a lovely scenic spot, with a sun rise. If you wish you can have a little time for walk to see the Nagarkot village. Then drive back to Kathmandu.

After lunch drive to Kirtipur. Kirtipur is located 5 km from the centre of Kathmandu. In Nepali dialect Kirtipur means "a glorious town". Looking down from its natural order it has been the scene of many historic battles and many important moments in Nepal's history. History says that the ancient city Kirtipur was founded by Shiva Deva between 1099 AD and 1126 AD and during the reign of the Malla Kingdom in the 15th century the city was developed for human settlement. The town is an ancient town, which consists of remarkable historical values and ethics. It is still an open museum of religion, culture and tradition and glorious work of Newari crafts and architecture. With majority of Newari community, the city house about 43,000 people approximately according to the data of year 2003. Kirtipur town is harmonical convergence of Buddhist and Hindus. Drive back to hotel.
