

7 DAYS BEAUTY OF NEPAL

Day 01 Kuala Lumpur - Kathmandu

Upon arrival at Kathmandu meet and greet by our local representative from **Clasic Tours sdn bhd**,transferred to the hotel. After a short rest by visiting the 2000 years old Swoyambhunath stupa, (UNESCO World heritage site in 1979) sometimes also known as the monkey temple. The temple charms with its great dazzling stupa, while at the same time offers a marvelous view of Kathmandu Valley. Next destination is Patan, (UNESCO World heritage site in 1979) the oldest and second largest of the three cities in Kathmandu valley. Patan likes to recall its old name LALITPUR (city of beauty). Above all, it remains a proud city of artisans; Patan produces nearly all Nepal's fine metal work. Enroute, stop at a Tibetan carpet factory where you can see the spinning, dyeing and weaving of Tibetan carpets. Drive back to hotel.

Day 02 Kathmandu – Pokhara

(B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will drive you up to Pokhara, the second largest and the most city in Nepal. Upon arrival, check in to hotel. In the evening, boating at Fewa lake for 1 hour. At the time of boating you have a chance to see the beautiful Himalayan panorama, specially (Fishtail) Machhapuchare, Annapurna, Dhaulagiri Himal. Walk back or drive back to hotel with lots of shopping in lake side area.

Day 03 Pokhara (B/L/D)

A half day tour of Pokhara is in store for you and we will visit various parts of the lakeside village, and enjoy one of the most beautiful panoramas in the world made up by the Annapurna Himal, the majestic Machhapuchhare and other surrounding snow-capped peaks. Afternoon or morning we will be visiting Davis fall, followed by the Tibetan refugee camp where the barter trading is still being practiced. Then we will be visiting old market of Pokhara and Vindhebasini temple as well as Seti George.

Day 04 Pokhara-Kathmandu

After breakfast drive to Kathmandu, after reach Katmandu check in hotel. Then free in the evening. In the evening you can do shopping or rest your own. If pax wish fly back from Pokhara to Kathmandu. Optional flight cost by Buddha air (USD 102.00 + USD 3.00 domestic tax)

Day05 Kathmandu-Nagarkot

(B/L/D)

After breakfast go for sightseeing we will be going to Kirtipur. Kirtipur is one of the oldest town in Kathmandu valley. Kirtipur contains few Buddhists sites old & new. Cilancho Stupa is of historic importance. A Bihar has been made in Kirtipur, which contain the miniature sites representing Lumbini, The birth place of Buddha, Boudhgaya where Buddha got enlighten, Saranath where Buddha gave his first teaching and Kushinagar where Buddha died. Above Chobhar in Kirtipur, we find the temple of Adinath which God is worshipped both by Hindu & Buddhist. After Kirtipur we will visit Chobhar Gorge, The Gorge cut by Manjushree to let the water of Kathmandu flow out of the valley is visible here. Then drive to Nagarkot. Nagarkot which is at a height of 2300 m above the sea level. From this lovely scenic spot you can catch the excellent view of the Himalayan range at sunset and even Mt. Everest on a clear day.

Day06 Nagarkot-Kathmandu

(B/L/D)

After breakfast drive to Kathmandu. Before reach hotel go for sightseeing tour to Boudhanath stupa. After reach Kathmandu Lunch. Then after a short rest go for sightseeing trip to see famous durbar square of Kathmandu, and Hanumandhoka (Hanuman gate) and Kasthamandap dominated by Shiva temple where the "Living virgin Goddess" Kumari lived. By the same time you will see God Shiva and Parvati temple, Narayan temple, Seto bhairab, Kal bhairab and Taleju temple, which was builted in 17th century. Drive back to hotel. Little time free for shopping or relax.
